Re: Omnibus Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Amendment Act of 2014

Dear Licensee:

A new law, the Omnibus Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Amendment Act of 2014, is scheduled to take effect on May 2, 2015 and may affect your business.

One of the provisions of the bill allows a class A manufacturer to apply for an On-Site Sales and Consumption Permit. The permit allows a distillery or winery to sell and serve beverages with spirits distilled by the distillery or wine manufactured by the winery for on-premises consumption from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m., seven days a week.

Class A manufacturers can apply for an On-Site Sales and Consumption Permit by completing the enclosed application and returning it to the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) by mail or in person:

ABRA will begin processing the applications after the Congressional review period expires for the Omnibus Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Amendment Act of 2014, which is projected to occur on May 2, 2015.

It is important to note that a class A manufacturer would still need to obtain a tasting permit in order to provide samples of spirits or wine to customers at no cost, even if they have the on-site sales and consumption permit.

The annual fee for the permit is \$1,000. Class A manufacturers that do not want to apply for an On-Site Sales and Consumption Permit are not required to do so.
