





SPRING/SUMMER CYCLE: PROJECT SUPPORT & FELLOWSHIPS



- 1. Registered as a 501(c)(3).**
- 2. Headquartered and incorporated in DC (No PO boxes).**
- 3. In good standing with DC and the DCCA.**
- 4. Compliance documents (e.g. Arrest and Conviction Statement, Certificate of Liability, Clean hands certification) and documents required for each program.**

Deadline: **May 18, 2016 at 4:00 p.m.**

New: DataArts no longer required at time of application

Organizations - Programs

East of the River Projects (EOR)



Supports projects benefitting residents in wards 7 & 8.

Deadline: **May 25, 2016 at 4:00 p.m.**

- New:** • EOR resident organizations now presented together at panel first, with 65% of program funding going to EOR resident organizations.
- DataArts report no longer required with application.

Support for acquisition of facilities within 6 months of closing or capital improvement projects and planning.

Deadline: **May 19, 2016 at 4:00 p.m.**

Projects, events and festivals promoting DC artists and humanities professionals and benefitting residents and visitors.

Deadline: **May 26, 2016 at 4:00 p.m.**

- New:**
- Support for Sister Cities Projects now included in PEF (I & O).
 - Projects reviewed in cohorts based on organizational cash expenses.

Organizations with FY15 cash expenses between \$250,000 and \$1,249,999 and one FTE by proof of W2 eligible.



Tips

- Be on the DCCAH listserv and follows us on social media for updates.
- Mark deadlines and dates sooner than it really is.
- Get your required and compliance documents out of the way first to ensure eligibility.
- Save your documents in a PDF format.
- Attend workshops, webchats and get to know your DCCAH program managers.
- Familiarize yourself with the program's guidelines and DCCAH portal if it's your first application.
