DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT

On Friday, July 26, 2013, at approximately 6:18 AM, DC Fire & EMS received a call for "an odor of smoke" coming from the 1000 block of Euclid Street, NW. Upon arriving on the scene, Fire & EMS personnel forced entry into the apartment and pulled **Randolph Scott Harris, Jr.** from the unit. He was severely burned and suffered from apparent multiple gunshot wounds. The Metropolitan Police Department seeks the public's assistance in gathering information regarding this incident.
