### DESCRIPTION

On Sunday, September 23, 2007, at approximately 10:05 pm, **Bryce Hemsley** was shot and killed in the 200 block of Florida Avenue, NE. Mr. Hemsley was observed operating a 1995 four-door bluish-green Grand Am at the time of the incident. The perpetrator in this case is believed to have been operating a red scooter similar to the one pictured above. The Metropolitan Police Department seeks the public's assistance in gathering information regarding this incident.
