3rd Quarter Report on Donations Approved by OPGS for FY 2013



Pursuant to Mayor's Order 2011-170, dated October 5, 2011, the Office of Partnerships and Grant Services (OPGS), in consultation with the Office of the Attorney General's Ethics Counselor, is publishing the District's 3rd Quarter Report on Donations for Fiscal Year 2013. The Order requires OPGS to review all requests by District officials to solicit or accept donations and approve or disapprove such requests as appropriate in accordance with the Rules of Conduct Governing Donations (Mayor Memorandum 2012-3) and D.C. Official Code Sec. 1-329.01 (2001). This report includes data on all donation requests approved by OPGS for the period beginning July 1, 2012 and ending September 31, 2012. During this period, OPGS approved the solicitation and/or acceptance of \$2,239,846.70 in donations of which \$87,168.08 represented financial contributions and \$2,152,678.62 were in-kind donations.
