

**Preventive Health and Health Services Block Grant
Pre-Application Meeting – April 25, 2014**

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- **Can an applicant submit more than one grant application for each focus area?**

Yes. You can submit more than one grant application. There is the potential to submit two (2) applications in Focus Area A and two (2) in Focus Area B. See Section IV of the RFA.

- **Is this RFA grant period only for one year of funding or with additional year continuation of funding?**

The Notice of Grant Award will be issued for **one year of funding**.

- **Can you include stipends and/or incentives in the budget of your grant application?**

Stipends are not allowed. The Preventive Health Block Grant Legislation does not allow stipends being paid to individuals.

The **use of incentives** depends on the intention offered. The incentive must be justified and very specific/detailed. All consideration would be reviewed and decided during the review process.

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- **Do organizations need a certificate of good standing or “clean hands agreement”?**

Items needed to submit this application/s are noted in Section E. pages 17-18 of the RFA.

- **Is there a specific start date to begin any awarded project?**

The project may begin once the successful applicants receive copies of the executed grant agreement and purchase order (PO). The grant period will be specified in the grant agreement.

- **Can necessary personnel be hired after the award is made?**

If the position is vacant in your grant application, indicate in the application the anticipated fill date and the significance of the position to the project.
