### NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY

#### **Increase Boating Access for Recreational Boaters to the Waterways of the District of Columbia**

The Department of Energy and Environment (the Department) seeks eligible entities to support one or more projects to provide boat access to the waterways of the District of Columbia. Total funding will not exceed \$400,000. DOEE will provide federal funds for up to 75% of the total project cost for one or more projects. This amount is subject to availability of funding. The applicant will be expected to supply the rest of the Project budget with a non-federal match of cash or an in-kind donation. The applicant will be the “subgrantee” of the federal funds. As such, it must be prepared to meet the requirements of the federal program providing the funding.

Beginning 10/14/2016, the full text of the Request for Applications (RFA) will be available. A person may obtain a copy of this RFA by any of the following means:

**The deadline for application submissions is 12/5/2016, at 5:00 p.m.** Five hard copies must be submitted to the above address and a complete electronic copy must be e-mailed to [2016wildliferfa.grants@dc.gov](mailto:2016wildliferfa.grants@dc.gov).

**Eligibility:** All the checked institutions below may apply for these grants:

- Nonprofit organizations, including those with IRS 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) determinations;
- Faith-based organizations;
- Government agencies
- Universities/educational institutions; and
- Private Enterprises.
