FY 2012 Grant Season

The DC Commission on the Arts and Humanities (DCCAH) announces the availability of grant funds for fiscal year 2012. DCCAH provides grants, programs and educational activities that encourage diverse artistic expressions and learning opportunities, so that all District of Columbia residents and visitors can experience the rich culture of our city.

Eligible applicants must be DC-based, non-profit organizations or individuals who have resided in the District of Columbia for at least one year. All eligible applications are reviewed through a competitive process. Evaluation criteria are based on 1) Artistic Content, 2) Community Engagement and 3) Organizational Impact, Capacity and Sustainability.

The Request for Applications (RFA) will be available electronically beginning Monday, July 11, 2011 on our website at <http://dcarts.dc.gov>.

Deadlines for applications will vary, beginning on August 22, 2011.
