## Juvenile Justice FY '13 Focus

- ✓ Compliance of Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) - Establish “zero tolerance” cultures for sexual assault in local adult and juvenile correctional facilities (CTF & CDF); consult with The Moss Group & subject matter experts to create a strong reporting culture; conduct Sexual Safety Assessment (SSA); conduct policy review; and develop a transformative leadership approach to overcome identified factors contributing to incidence of sexual abuse.

- ✓ Compliance of Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (SORNA)/Adam Walsh Act – funds 3 /4 phase proposal for DC.
- Phase 1, 2,3 : Develop new interfaces for the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) to interact with CSOSA's Sex Offender Registry; enhance MPD's database to add new data requirements and kiosks; email notification to citizens through newly designed web portals.
- × Phase 4 – Juvenile Registration (not funded; need TA from the SMART Office/NCJA)

# Strategic Planning -Projections

- Federal applications to pursue funding of evidence based practices (OMB Circular/Congressional language)
- Identify DC 's Public Safety and Justice Cluster Priorities to pursue evidence based practices (EBP)
- Encourage home-grown EBPs by setting program standards and evaluation of programs.

# Strategic Planning –Projections

- PSJ Cluster to collaborate and infuse knowledge of priorities with the State Administering Agency (SAA/ JGA) & Statistical Analysis Center (SAC /CJCC) – Annual Strategic Planning Process
- PSJ Cluster to collaborate with Health/Human Services Cluster to streamline referral and service delivery processes
- Collaborate with SAA & SAC to show case data driven strategies in federal applications
