***CONSOLIDATED JUSTICE GRANTS FY 2017 PRIORITY/PURPOSE AREAS:**

COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS AND JUVENILE DELINQUENCY PREVENTION PROGRAMS

The District of Columbia's Office of Victim Services and Justice Grants(OVSJG) announces the availability of funds to implement culturally-competent and community-based services within two priority/purpose areas: (1) Community Corrections(reentry);and (2) Juvenile Delinquency Prevention programs. Applicants are encouraged to implement data-driven and scientific-based practices to enhance community-based services, and to address mental health/substance abuse needs of program participants. Partnerships with District agencies are encouraged. Only one application per entity will be awarded as listed in the *FY 2017 COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS AND JUVENILE DELINQUENCY PROGRAMS CONSOLIDATED RFA #2017-01.

Eligibility: Nonprofit organizations (Category 1) and District government agencies (Category 2) are eligible to apply for up to \$100,000. Eligible entities must have capacity to provide services effective October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.
