

## NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY

### Green Zone Environmental Program's (GZEP) Summer Youth and Young Adults Watershed Protection Education and Job Training

The Department of Energy and Environment (the Department) seeks eligible entities to provide education, training, and hands-on activities related to watershed protection for 30-50 youth and young adults in the Green Zone Environmental Program. The amount available for the project is approximately \$60,000 from the date of the award through September 30, 2017. DOEE expects to make multiple awards for up to \$20,000. This amount is subject to availability of funding and approval by the appropriate agencies.

**Eligibility:** All the checked institutions below may apply for these grants:

- Nonprofit organizations, including those with IRS 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) determinations;
- Faith-based organizations;
- Government agencies
- Universities/educational institutions; and
- Private Enterprises.
