Prevention Centers (Wards 1 & 2; Wards 5 & 6)

The Government of the District of Columbia's Department of Health (DOH) Addiction Prevention and Recovery Administration (APRA) is soliciting applications from qualified non-profit and for-profit community-based organizations currently addressing community, public health, and substance abuse with families, youth, and children.

These funds will be awarded by APRA through a cooperative agreement using funds provided by the United States Department of Health and Human Services' (DHHS), Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) through the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant.

Approximately \$420,000 will be available to fund two Prevention Centers in Wards 1 & 2 and Wards 5 & 6 to provide access to substance abuse prevention in order to strengthen communities as places where children and youth are healthy and drug-free.

The Request for Application (RFA # APRA PC083112) will be released Friday, August 31, 2012. The RFA will be posted on the Office of Partnerships and Grants Services website, www.opgs.dc.gov under the District Grants Clearinghouse. **The deadline for submission is Monday, October 1, 2012 at 4:45 pm.**
