# What Do We Do?



- Fund programs to deliver services for persons living with HIV/AIDS and their families.
- Monitor programs for compliance.
- Ensure program accountability, effectiveness, efficiency, responsiveness, and quality.



# How Do We Award Funding?



- Care, Housing and Support Services Bureau receives federal awards from Housing and Urban Development and Health and Human Services.
- CHSS awards the federal and some local funds through a District of Columbia competitive bid process. Requests for Applications (RFA) are announced. Applicants must meet the requirements outlined in the RFA.



# How Do We Award Funding?



- Primary programs funded are:
  - Ryan White Parts A, B and MAI
  - Housing Opportunities for People With AIDS (HOPWA)



# Ryan White Program



- The goal of the Ryan White Program is to improve the quality and availability of HIV-related care and treatment for income eligible people living with HIV/AIDS (PLWH/A) and to improve health outcomes.



# HOPWA



- The goal of Housing Opportunities for People With AIDS Program is to improve the quality and availability of housing for income eligible people with HIV/AIDS.



# AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP)



- DC ADAP provides direct services eligible clients with private health insurance or Medicare.
- Services provided through ADAP are:
  - Eligibility screening for free HIV drugs
  - Payment of premiums, co-pays, and deductibles for insurance such as COBRA.

- Treatment Adherence
- Oral Health Care
- Medical Case Management
- Behavioral Health
  - Mental Health Services
  - Substance Abuse Services





# What Type of Services?



- Burial Assistance
- Early Intervention Services
- Emergency Financial Assistance
- Food, Food Bank, and Home-Delivered Meals
- Housing Programs
  - Facility Based Housing (Transitional or Emergency)
  - Supportive Services



# Purpose of Program Monitoring



To determine:

- Compliance with federal, state and local legislative requirements
- Compliance with program expectations and best practices
- Compliance with grant deliverables
- Achievement of program goals and objectives
- Achievement of performance indicators (process and outcome measures)



# Program Monitoring Outcomes



- Effectiveness of program delivery
- Efficient use of funds
- Responsiveness to client needs
- Quality of health and support services



# Program Monitoring Impact



- People living longer and healthier with HIV due to optimal care and treatment and decreased disparities in the health care continuum

# Sub-Grantee Reports Requirements



- Monthly Performance Reports
- Quarterly Cumulative Reports
- End-of-Year Program Reports (Close-Out)
- End-of-Year Data Reports
- Invoicing

- The HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis, STD & TB Administration (HAHSTA) provides technical assistance for all sub-grantees to build organizational capacity and ensure achievement of program deliverables.

  - Year-2 of a 3-year funding cycle begins (March 1, 2014 – February 28, 2015)
- **Ryan White Part B**
  - Year-2 of a 3-year funding cycle begins (April 1, 2014 – March 31, 2015)
- **HOPWA**
  - Year-1 of 3-year funding cycle began (October 1, 2013 – September 30, 2014)
