Health and Physical Education Assessment Data Collection 2015-16 School Year

The District of Columbia's Healthy Schools Act of 2010 requires the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) to collect and report student performance on DC Health and Physical Education Standards. OSSE is committed to supporting Local Education Agencies (LEAs) to comply with this law, while also being sensitive to the administrative burdens associated with the District-wide assessment and wanting to allow for LEA innovation and flexibility in how to measure those standards. To that end, OSSE is transitioning from a secure standardized Health and Physical Education Assessment to a new model for Health and Physical Education Assessment Data Collection, designed to leverage instructional plans your LEA already has in place. LEAs and schools are still expected to address all grade-level Health and Physical Education Standards through curriculum and instruction. However, the Health Assessment Data Collection represents a sample of standards assessed within an LEA/school's larger instructional plan. We are excited about this new approach and look forward to working with your LEA on how we can improve this process in future years. To complete the Health and Physical Education Assessment Data Collection, LEAs will do the following:

STEP 1: Complete and submit the LEA Health and Physical Education Assessment Plan

STEP 2: Submit your LEA's Health and Physical Education Assessment Performance Data

OSSE reporting categories and standards will be used to complete both steps.

Reporting Categories & Assessed Standards

LEAs will assess students and provide student-level data in the following Reporting Categories:

LEAs will receive a list of OSSE-approved standards for inclusion in their Health and Physical Education assessment plan. LEAs will be asked to select a specified number of standards in each reporting category for inclusion in their Health and Physical Education Assessment Plan for the 2015-16 school year. This approach provides LEAs with flexibility to choose which standards to include in this data collection, while ensuring that OSSE obtains sufficient data from each reporting category. The following section details the steps for completing the LEA plan and data collection, and provides a timeline for the 2015-16 Health and Physical Education Assessment Data Collection.

STEP 1: LEA Health and Physical Education Assessment Plan Submission

LEAs will complete a Health and Physical Education Assessment Plan worksheet (provided by OSSE) and submit to OSSE.assessment@dc.gov by February 1, 2016.

Evidence, Scoring Method, and Performance Levels

LEAs may use a broad range of evidence to determine student performance on standards selected for the LEA's Health and Physical Education Assessment Plan. This evidence can range from administering paper-and-pencil assessment instruments, to performance tasks, to interviews/questionnaires, to observational rubrics of student activity, and more. Three considerations should be kept in mind when designing evidence that will be collected in the LEA Health and Physical Education Assessment Plan:

1. Does the evidence collected reflect student learning of the standard?
2. Does this evidence reflect individual student work or perspective?
3. Can the scoring method for this evidence be transformed into a 5-level performance scale?

Please note, while data will be submitted to OSSE during a single data collection window, LEA's do not need to collect evidence at a single point in time. An LEA's collection of evidence is at its

discretion, as it will often align with the LEA's curricular maps and instructional plans in Health and Physical Education.

Alongside determining evidence that will be used to demonstrate student learning, LEAs will include in the Health and Physical Education Assessment Plan how they will score each evidence. The scoring system selected is at LEAs discretion (points, scales, etc.), as long as it is clear how those scores will be transformed into five (5) OSSE-defined performance levels:

- Level 5 - Exceeded Expectations
- Level 4 - Met Expectations
- Level 3 - Approached Expectations
- Level 2 - Partially Met Expectations
- Level 1 - Did Not Meet Expectations

LEA Health and Physical Education Assessment Plan Evaluation and Approval

OSSE will review Health and Physical Education Assessment Plans and rate each in one of two categories: **Approved** or **Revise and Resubmit**. If an LEA is asked to **Revise and Resubmit** a plan, OSSE will provide detailed written feedback and be available for technical assistance to ensure your plan is revised to meet the expectations for this assessment.

Optional: Administer OSSE HPE Exam

OSSE will also make available a paper-and-pencil OSSE Health & Physical Education (HPE) Exam for those LEAs who would prefer to administer a common assessment. The assessment will be comprised of prior DC CAS Health Assessment items and will be locally scored by LEAs and/or schools. The OSSE HPE Exam will be available to LEAs in spring 2016, and details on the OSSE HPE Exam will be available in January 2016. LEAs will submit the student performance data from the OSSE HPE Exam using the data submission process described below.

STEP 2: Performance Data Submission

All student performance data will be submitted by June 15, 2016. OSSE will provide your LEA with a spreadsheet pre-populated with your 5th, 8th, and High School students registered for the District-wide Assessment and the OSSE-approved Health and Physical Education Assessment Standards. LEAs will populate the spreadsheet with the performance levels (1-5) by standard for each student. Please note, for High School, prior to dissemination of data collection templates, OSSE will collect from LEAs a roster of those high school students who will participate in the Health and Physical Education Assessment Data Collection for the current year.
